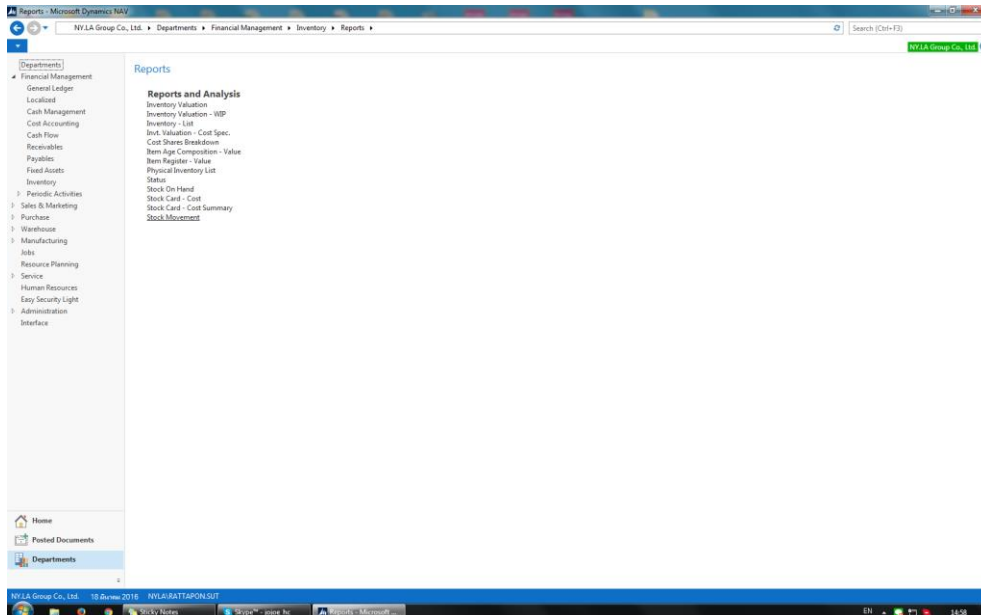


Trip & Trick NAV

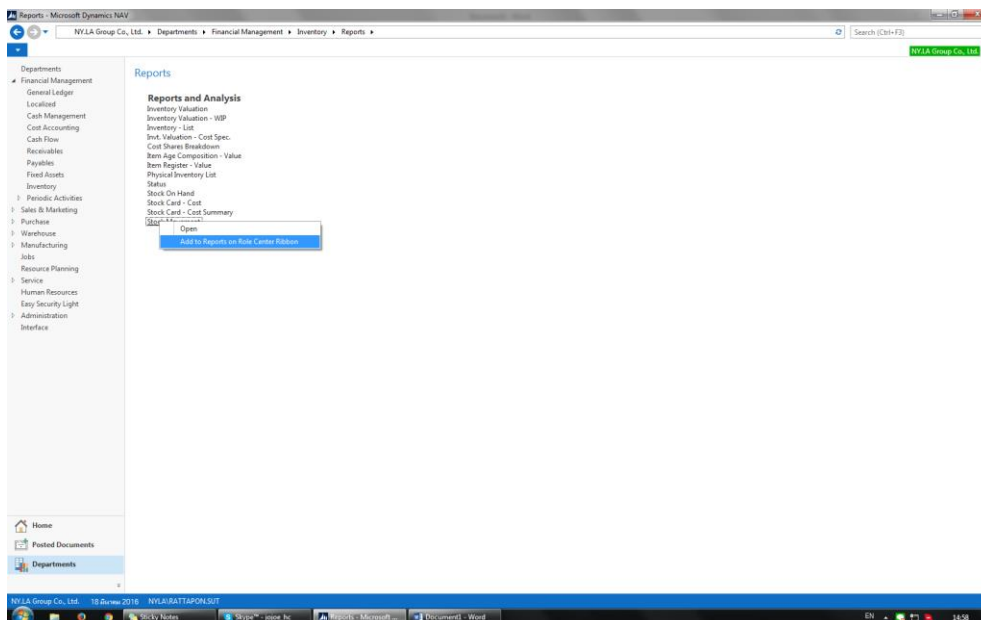
บางคนคงเบื่อกับการกดหา หัวข้อใน Search เช่น พิมพ์ Stock Movement
